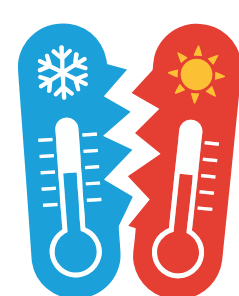


INFORMATION ABOUT THE HOST CITY

PLACES TO VISIT IN GUADALAJARA

The Teatro Degollado—located at the corner of Belén and Morelos streets in Guadalajara, Jalisco—is a 19th-century Neoclassical gem featuring a spectacular interior, a fresco-adorned ceiling, and excellent acoustics; it serves as an epicenter where traditions and cultural expressions converge.

Guadalajara Cathedral, located at Avenida Alcalde No. 10, is an iconic architectural landmark of the city.

The Cabañas Museum, located at Cabañas No. 8, is a must-visit destination where art and history intertwine. This Neoclassical building has been transformed into a vibrant cultural center. The complex was built in 1810 based on designs by architect Manuel Tolsá and under the supervision of master builder José Gutiérrez. Originally constructed as the *Casa de la Caridad y Misericordia* (House of Charity and Mercy) of Guadalajara, it was established in 1980 as a venue for hosting exhibitions of national and international stature. The building comprises 23 courtyards, 106 rooms, 78 corridors, and two chapels. In 1997, UNESCO designated it a World Heritage Site. A visit to the Cabañas Museum is essential, particularly to view the collection of murals by José Clemente Orozco. In these murals, Orozco reflects his perspective on the human condition, social struggle, and the great challenges facing humanity. One of his most iconic and representative works is *Hombre de Fuego* (Man of Fire)—located in the building's central dome—which is recognized as a 20th-century masterpiece.

Tequila, Jalisco. Renowned for its namesake spirit, this charming town offers the chance to tour distilleries, enjoy tastings, and admire breathtaking landscapes amidst blue agave fields. Immerse yourself in the rich culture and tradition of tequila at this unmissable destination located near Guadalajara.

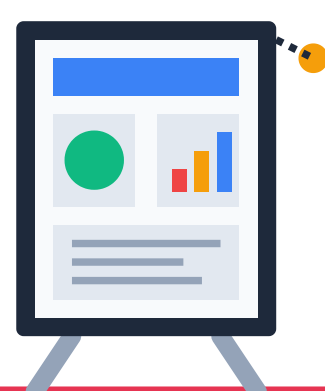

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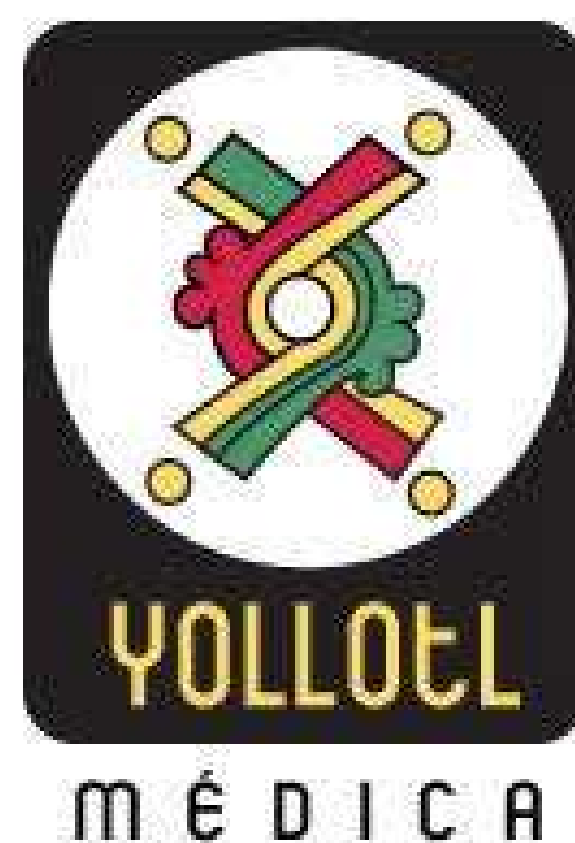
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
